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## El Paso County Public Health Programs and Services

### **Clinical Services**

Physician and Nurse Practitioners provide health and cancer screenings for women including Pap tests, pelvic and breast exams, pregnancy tests, counseling, and birth control including Long Acting Reversible Contraceptives (LARC). Additionally we offer education, exams, and treatment for sexually transmitted illnesses (STIs/STDs). Same-day appointments are often available.

### **Immunizations and International Travel Clinic**

Licensed Nurses provide immunizations for children and adults. HPV vaccines can be coordinated with Clinical Services appointments. We can also provide off-site travel vaccinations for large groups upon request with advance notice.

### **Nurse Family Partnership**

Public Health Nurses provide home visits to low-income, first-time parents and their children. We promote healthy pregnancies and healthy babies while building positive parenting skills and providing community resources. Home visits begin with women during pregnancy and continue until the child is 2 years old.

### **Women, Infants and Children (WIC)**

Registered Dietitians and Health Educators provide supplemental food vouchers, child development and nutrition education, and breastfeeding counseling for pregnant women, postpartum women, and to infants and children up to age five. Income eligibility requirements are listed at [www.elpasocountyhealth.org](http://www.elpasocountyhealth.org). WIC offices are located in Fountain and Colorado Springs.

### **Insurance Accepted**

For Clinical Services and the Immunization Clinic, we accept Medicaid, including Community Cares Medicaid. A sliding fee for uninsured patients is available.
