The IC became the first Independent Living Center in Colorado and the second in the nation to get approval to begin the Veteran directed Home Community Based Services program.




Our Community Organizing team conducted 10 focus groups and a 'Housing for All' community forum to ditermine ways to help ease the housing crunch for people with low incomes.


